MEDICINE POLICY

In accordance with national advice and guidelines, and in collaboration with the school nurse service, we have updated our medicine policy. A copy of this can be found on the St Bartholomew's Multi Academy Trust website. (This can be accessed via the St Bart's website.) One of the policy changes is that we are now unable to administer medicines that have not been prescribed by a doctor. We will be able to administer common, over the counter medicines (such as Gaviscon, Piriton and Calpol) that have been prescribed. A permission form must be completed in order for us to do this. We will be implementing this policy immediately after the half term break.

THE STAG'S HEAD

The Stag's Head has recently come under new management. I have met with the new landlord who is very keen to support the school in any way that he can. This includes supporting school events and the PFA. He is also happy for parents to use the car park for drop offs and pick-ups.
